In English we will be learning to:

Explore and write a range of fiction genres Write diary entries, biographical recounts, poetry, as well as non-chronological reports. Use a range of punctuation and grammatical skills to write gold and platinum standard texts. Develop a range of reading skills. Spell the lists of words in the KS2 curriculum.



In Maths we will be learning all about :

Interpreting statistical representations and calculating mean

Percentages and Roman numerals (to 100)
Multiplying and dividing with fractions
Coordinates, translation and reflection
Algebra, Order of Operations and Roman
Numerals

Division methods and division with 2 digit divisors (Y6 only)

Area, perimeter and volume (Y6 only)

Questions we'll be asking...

- What problems did the Mayans face that could explain their decline?
- Who were the Maya people and when and where in the world did they live?
- What were the religious beliefs of the Maya people and how did they worship?
- How does the Maya number system work?
- What was the Maya civilisation like?
- What does the Mayan writing system consist of?
- What foods were eaten by the ancient Maya people and why were certain foods particularly significant?

In Science we will be learning to:

Force and magnets: Compare how things move on different surfaces. Notice that some forces need contact between two objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance. Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object. Identify the effect of drag forces, such as air resistance, water resistance and friction that act between moving surfaces. Understand that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

In Computing we will be learning to:

Online safety: To gain a greater understanding of the impact that sharing digital content can have. To review sources of support when using technology and children's responsibility to one another in their online behaviour. To know how to maintain secure passwords. To be aware of appropriate and inappropriate text, photographs and videos and the impact of sharing these online. To search the Internet with a consideration for the reliability of the results of sources to check validity and understand the impact of incorrect information.

In RE we will be learning to:

The children will understand what it means if God is holy and loving. They will explore if religion and science both can be right. The children will explore how Easter is celebrated around the world.

In French we will be learning to:

Read, write, listen to and say words, phrases and sentences on the following topics:
What do you like to eat?
Would you like to meet my family?

In PE we will be learning to:

Plan, prepare and perform on stage at the Sports Partnership Dance Festival at Hertford Theatre. Develop and improve their knowledge and skills in gymnastics.

In History/Georgraphy we will be learning to:

Investigate what life was like in Mayan times by using a variety of artefacts and sources. In Geography we will be looking at what life is like in the Amazon.

In Music we will be learning about:

Around the world linked to Geography. The children will explore pentatonic melodies and syncopated rhythms, learning that the fundamental dimensions of music are the same all over the world.

In Art we will be learning to:

National Gallery – Take one picture. To use drawing techniques e.g. observe, sketch, record, review, use texture and tone etc.

In PSHE we will be learning to:

Understand how to carry out basic first aid including for burns, scalds, cuts, bleeds, choking, asthma attacks or allergic reactions. Understand that if someone has experienced a head injury, they should not be moved. Recognise when it is appropriate to use first aid and the importance of seeking adult help. Understand about the different types of relationships people have in their lives and how friends and family communicate together; how the internet and social media can be used positively. Recognise how to ask for help or advice and respond to pressure, inappropriate contact or concerns about personal safety.
